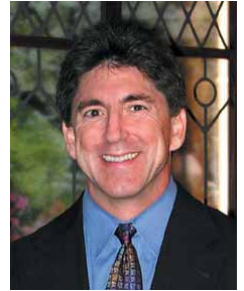

“THE CREED - THE WEDDING BAND OF FAITH”

For a single parish RCIA program, or for the entire deanery.

Talk 1: What does it mean to believe?

The difference between mere belief and living faith, illustrated by Dr. D'Ambrosio's own experience of conversion.

✚ 50 minute talk followed by prayer, question and answer session.

Talk 2: “We Believe in one God, the Father Almighty”

The concept of faith as an intimate relationship with God as loving Father is unique to Christianity.

The person and work of Christ— his humanity and divinity, the meaning of his death and resurrection, his coming again in glory.

Talk 4: “We Believe in the Holy Spirit”

The person and work of the Holy Spirit— how the life-changing power of the Holy Spirit makes the gospel truly good news, illustrated from the experience of the apostles as well as the personal experience of Dr. D'Ambrosio

✚ 50 minute talk followed by a question and answer session.
