ITINERARY

TDAY 1, Monday, September 6: DEPART USA

Depart on an overnight flight to Florence. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Group air is confirmed from Dallas/Fort Worth and Albuquerque. To qualify for the group rate used for pricing, at least ten passengers must travel from the same airport. Add-on rates are available from most major cities

PDAY 2, Tuesday, September 7: FLORENCE

Welcome to Italy! Upon arrival, we are greeted by our English-speaking tour manager who will be with the group during our entire stay in Italy. We board the private deluxe bus and transfer to our hotel. Mass will be celebrated Dinner and overnight in Florence. (D)

TDAY 3, Wednesday, September 8: FLORENCE

This morning after our open buffet breakfast, which is included each day, we have a full-day tour of the Renaissance city, starting with the Convent of San Marco. The priory, which is now a museum, was home to two famous Dominicans of the fifteenth century, the fiery preacher Savonarola and the saintly artist, Fra Angelico, whose frescos adorn the walls of the convent. Next, we visit the Accademia Gallery, home to one of the most famous sculptures in the world, Michelangelo's David. During the break for lunch on our own, we suggest visiting the famous "San Lorenzo Market". It is a swarm of colors and scents and is a kitchen gourmet's muse, with its plethora of artisan bread in all shapes and sizes, stands overflowing with in-season fruits and vegetables fresh from the farms, and an immense variety of cheeses and cured meats. After lunch, we explore the Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, with its great representation of Tuscan Gothic Architecture. The giant dome of the church was designed by Brunelleschi. We see Giotto's Bell Tower, a 14th-century masterpiece that rises to a height of 292 feet, and the Baptistry of San Giovanni, with its East Door, called the "Gates of Paradise," which took the artist Ghiberti, 27 years to complete. The remainder of the late afternoon is at leisure to explore additional treasures of Florence on our own. The outdoor Ponte Vecchio, covered since medieval times with goldsmiths' shops, is a must for Florence's other specialty - handcrafted gold jewelry. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight in Florence. (B.D.)

DAY 4, Thursday, September 9: FLORENCE - ASSISI

After breakfast and hotel checkout, we walk to Michelangelo's parish church, Santa Croce, where Dante is buried. Continue with the guide to Piazza Della Signoria, and visit the quaint Bargello museum, which houses a lovely collection of Florentine art by Michelangelo and others. Next, we visit, Santa Maria Novella to see the famous Trinity by Masaccio. Break for lunch. In the afternoon, we bid farewell to Renaissance Florence and make our way to Assisi, the hometown of the great Saint, whose name was taken by our current Pope. We begin our visit at the Portiuncula, one of the chapels rebuilt by St. Francis, and St. Mary of the Angels Church. Dinner and overnight in the magical, medieval hill town of Assisi. (B.D.)

PDAY 5, Friday, September 10: ASSISI

Today we visit the Basilica of St. Francis. The upper Basilica with Giotto's frescos representing the life of St. Francis, then the lower Basilica and the Tomb of St. Francis. We proceed walking up to the Basilica of St. Clare, After a break for lunch on our own, we will be transferred by vans to the Convent of San Damiano, where St. Francis received his call to rebuild the Church and where St. Clare lived and died. We also visit the Carceri Hermitage, a series of caves on Mt. Subasio, above Assisi, to which St. Francis and the friars frequently retreated to meditate and pray. Return to Assisi. Time at leisure before dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B.D.)

†DAY 6, Saturday, September 11: ASSISI - ORVIETO-ROME

We depart Assisi and drive to Rome via Orvieto and visit the gothic Cathedral built to house the holy relics of the Eucharistic Miracle of Orvieto. It was this miracle that occasioned the proclamation of the Feast of Corpus Christi and inspired St. Thomas Aquinas to write the famous hymn "Tantum Ergo." We enjoy lunch in a local restaurant with tasting of the Orvieto and Orvieto Classico wine this region is famous for. In the afternoon, we proceed to Rome and settle into our hotel for dinner and overnight in Rome. (B.L.D)

DAY 7, Sunday, September 12: CHRISTIAN ROME

We concelebrate Mass with the locals this morning before going to see the Holy Father praying the Angelus at noon from the window of his study overlooking Saint Peter's Square. After the

Marcellino D'Ambrosio is a NY Times best-selling author and a renowned commentator on Catholic issues appearing on Fox News' "Geraldo Rivera At Large" and Bill O'Reilly's radio show. A doctoral student of the renowned Avery Cardinal Dulles, he is known as "Dr. Italy" due to his special expertise in the history, culture, and cuisine of the Italian people. Dr. Italy will be our principal guide on this pilgrimage, providing expert commentary on the art, saints, and heritage of Rome, Florence, and Assisi.

Angelus, Pope Francis will give his Apostolic Blessing, which extends to you, your loved ones, and any devotional items that you have brought with you to be blessed. Following lunch, we visit St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran, the Holy Stairs, and Holy Cross in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B.L.D.)

DAY 8, Monday, September 13: IMPERIAL ROME - BAROQUE ROME

We begin our day visiting the fascinating Church of San Clemente, an early Christian basilica in Rome dedicated to Pope St. Clement (d. 99 AD). In the 19th century, excavations under the present basilica uncovered not only the original, fourth-century basilica directly underneath, but also, on an even lower level, the remains of the first-century Christian house church that most probably was the home of Pope St. Clement, the third successor of St. Peter. We walk to the Colosseum, where fights between men and beasts, gladiatorial contests, races, and simulated naval battles took place in the arena, and which was dedicated to the memory of the Christian martyrs by Pope Benedict XIV. Continue to the Roman Forum, the religious, political, and commercial center of ancient Rome, and for centuries, the entire civilized world. We see the Arches of Constantine & Titus. By bus, we then reach Piazza Navona where we break for lunch. In the afternoon we continue our visit walking to the Pantheon and the Church of Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, where St. Catherine of Siena is buried under the main altar before. From here we reach the Trevi Fountain. The balance of the afternoon and evening is at leisure, giving us an opportunity to visit the fashion shopping district around the Spanish Steps on our own, or to return to the hotel to rest. Overnight in Rome. (B. Dinner is at leisure)

[†]DAY 9, Tuesday, September 14: VATICAN TREASURES

This morning, we start our tour with a visit to the Vatican Museum. Here we see the magnificent rooms painted by Raphael as well as the Sistine Chapel. We continue with a tour of St. Peter's Basilica which includes the Scavi, also known as the Vatican Necropolis, the excavations under St. Peter's where St. Peter was buried after his martyrdom. There will be free time to pray in one of the chapels, ascend to the top of the cupola, visit the Basilica's treasury, or shop for souvenirs. The afternoon is at leisure to explore Rome on our own. Overnight in Rome. (B. Dinner is at leisure.)

廿DAY 10, Wednesday, September 15: PAPAL AUDIENCE AND THE CATACOMBS

We return to Vatican City to attend a Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square with Pope Francis, surrounded by the Magnificent colonnade of Bernini. Following lunch, we drive to the Catacombs of St. Sebastian, to venerate the tombs of the martyrs, and see some of the earliest examples of Christian art. Continue to the Basilica dedicated to the other great apostle of Rome, St. Paul Outside the Walls. Return to the hotel to rest. Tonight we enjoy a farewell dinner in a local restaurant. Overnight in Rome. (B.L. Special dinner)

This morning we are transferred to the airport for our flight back to the USA. (B)
